## YOUTH GROUP

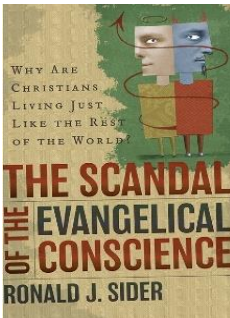
