YOUTH MISSION TRIP TO RAPID CITY

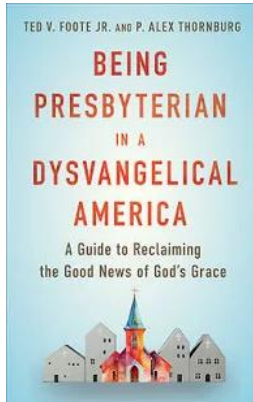

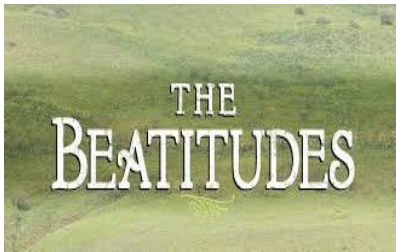
