Next 3 Months

1. Set criteria that our Mission Partners must meet to continue to be in service with us.
 - a. Use sample criteria that Bob Dick shared with us as a starting point to set PCB's criteria for Mission Partners.
2. Write a Race Manual for our 5K Race
 - a. The Mission Committee will combine all information regarding past races into a manual for planning guidelines for future races.
 - b. Information to be placed in a binder and a shared online file for future reference (Google shared folder).
3. Evaluate our Mission partners and events with regards to the new set criteria
 - a. Review all past and present mission opportunities.

Next 6 Months

1. Make a yearly calendar to prepare for events with our Mission Partners
 - a. Plan for the upcoming calendar year the Mission Committee events.
 - b. The events to include fundraisers.
 - c. Get calendar approved if needed by Session.
 - d. Share approved calendar with church members well in advance of the events by using social media and church communication methods.
 - e. Set each year's calendar by the end of November of the previous year.
2. Become a Mission Engaged Church. Be present with our Mission partners and engage with them. Not just with a financial commitment.
3. Grow the Mission Team.
 - a. It is ideal to have one mission committee member assigned to one mission partner to be the liaison between the mission partner and PCB.
 - b. A team of 9 people but will depend on the final result of how many Mission partners we finalize after reviewing the new criteria.
4. Continue to support and have yearly Youth Mission Trips.
 - a. Work with Youth to decide where next year's mission trip will be.
 - b. Set Mission Trip Fundraisers (March Madness, ?) to be placed on the yearly Mission Calendar.

Next 5 Years:

1. Have a combined Youth and Adult Mission Trip every 5 years.
 - a. Set fundraising goals well in advance to support said Mission Trip.
 - b. Work with the Mission Committee to determine where the mission trip will be.
 - c. Work with the Mission Committee to determine what will be accomplished during the trip.
