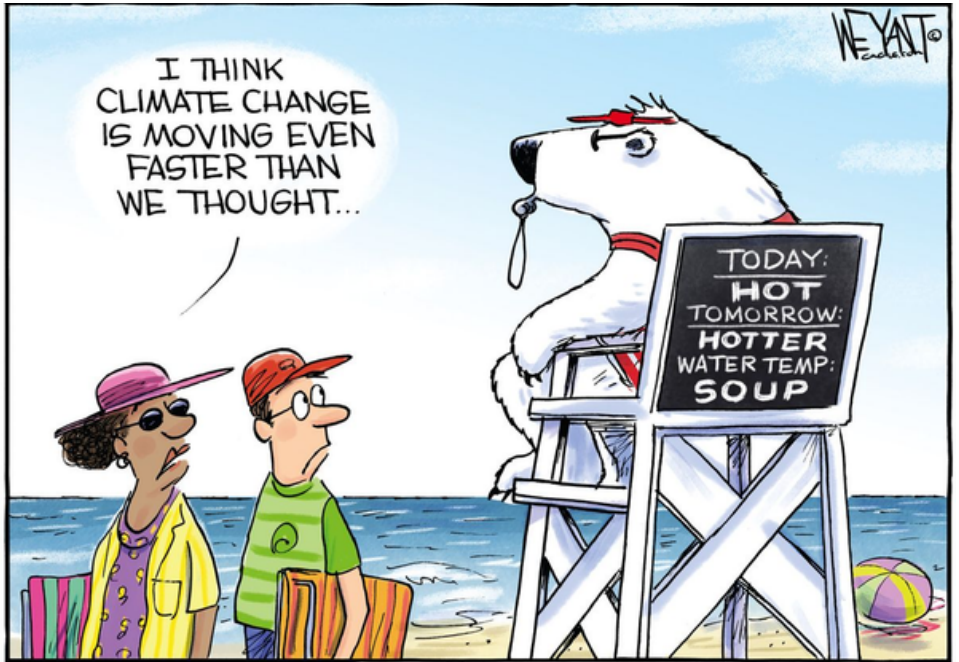

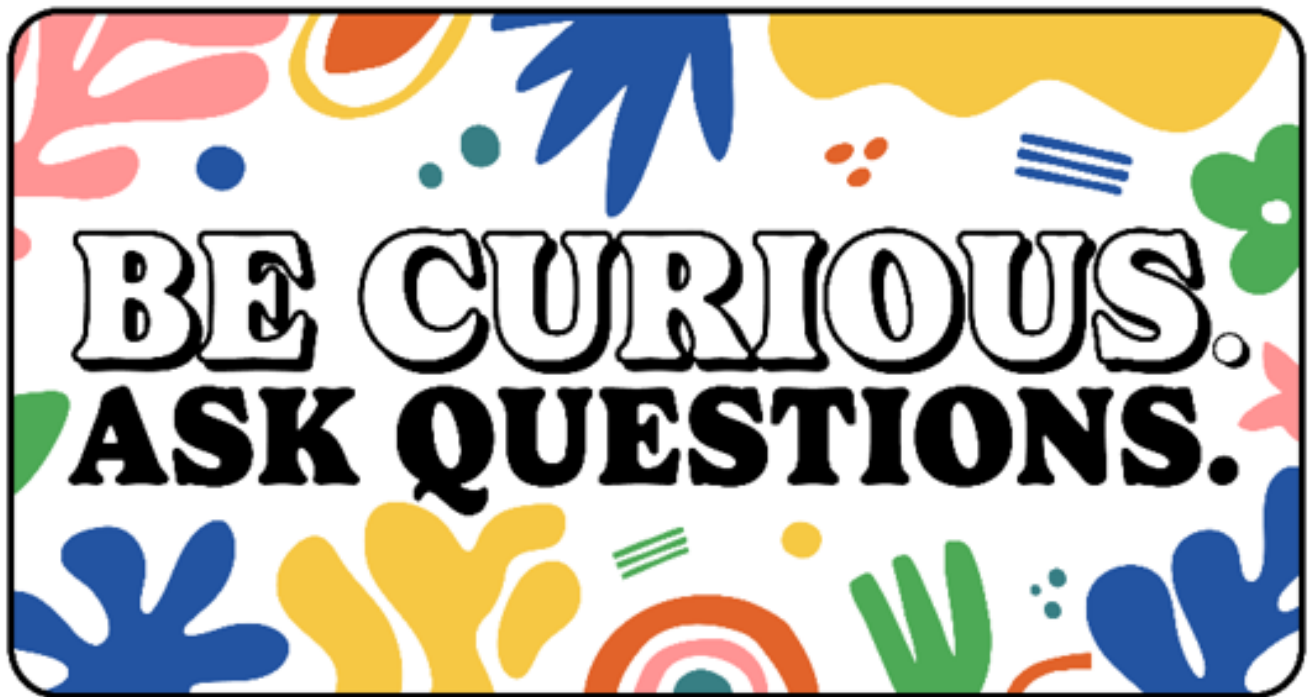


OUTDOOR WORSHIP
